
Private Malcolm BROWN

Private No 20 Malcolm Brown was born at Moonee Ponds, Victoria to Edmund Joseph and Annie Brown. Their later address was 252 New St Brighton, Victoria. He was a 20 year old agricultural student when he enlisted in Sydney NSW. He was 5'7 tall, weighed 11 stone 10 lbs, with fair complexion, brown eyes and brown hair.

He embarked with the 2nd Battalion, A Coy from Sydney, NSW on board HMAT A23 Suffolk on 18 Oct 1914.


Private Brown was killed in action 2 May 1915 at Gallipoli aged 21 years. He has no known grave but is commemorated on the Lone Pine Memorial (Panel 17) Gallipoli, Turkey.

He is also commemorated on the Roll of Honour at the Australian War Memorial (Panel 31), the Brighton Grammar School Roll of Honour and Bayside's Fallen plaque at Green Point, Brighton Beach, Victoria.
